3. Lori got \$8.00 for her birthday from her grandparents. She wanted to buy a teddy bear and a book with the money. How much money do her items cost? How much more money does Lori need in order to get both things?
4. If mom sends Jessica to the store to buy eight safety pins, how much money will she need for the purchase?
5. Andy just left the store, but is not sure that the cashier gave him the correct change. His total was \$4.75 and he gave the cashier \$10.00. If he is holding \$6.25, did the cashier give him the right amount of money? How much money (more or less) did Andy get than he was supposed to?
